I. VISA

Please, check your condition depending on your nationality (https://france-visas.gouv.fr/fr_FR/web/france-visas). Please contact us well in advance if you require Sciences Po Bordeaux to send you a letter of invitation.

II. TRAVELLING TO BORDEAUX

The Bordeaux-Mérignac airport about 8 km away from the centre of Bordeaux.

From the airport :

- To Bordeaux city center,
 - o 45 minute by bus, liane 1 to Gare Saint Jean. 1.70 euros
 - o 35 minutes by taxi. About 40 euros
- To Sciences Po Bordeaux,
 - o 50 minutes by bus, liane 1 to Gare Saint Jean – Change at Vigneau - liane 34 to Rives d'Arcins – Stop at *Faculté Droit et Lettres*. 1.70 euros
 - o 25 minutes by taxi. About 35 euros

From Bordeaux city center to Sciences Po Bordeaux 35-40 minutes by tram (tram B, direction of Pessac Alouette, stop at Montaigne-Montesquieu station Sciences Po Bordeaux and its logo will appear on your right handside just before that stop).
