Classification of conflicts

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Conflicts?



- represent a complex socio-psychological, political phenomenon**
- very diverse and can be classified according to different criteria**



The most common classification of conflicts based on criteria such as:

- 1) the parties to the conflict;
- 2) the nature of the requirement, infringement of which caused the conflict;
- 3) the focus of the conflict;
- 4) temporal parameters of the conflict;
- 5) the impact of conflict



Depending on the parties to the conflict are divided into:

- ✓ ***intrapersonal;***
- ✓ ***interpersonal;***
- ✓ ***between the individual and the group;***
- ✓ ***intergroup;***
- ✓ ***international.***



In the aspect of needs, the blocking of which was the prerequisite of the conflict, they can be divided into:

✓ *material;*

✓ *status and role;*

✓ *spiritual*



On the direction of the conflicts are divided into:

✓ *horizontal - between business partners, work colleagues;*

✓ *vertical – between subordinates*



Timing conflicts are divided into:

- ✓ *short;*
- ✓ *transient variation;*
- ✓ *long, lasting sometimes for years and decades, which are often public, national and religious conflicts.*



according to the criterion impact, the conflicts are divided into two types:

✓ *constructive, normal, positive, in which a group where they occur, retain their integrity, and the relationship between members of the group – the nature of collaboration, cooperation;*

✓ *destructive, pathological, negative when relations between people are becoming uncivilized, the nature of the confrontation, struggle, leading even to the destruction and disintegration of the organization.*

Base of classification	Kinds of conflicts	General characteristics
The sphere of existence of the conflict	Economic	Based on the economic contradictions
	Ideological	Based on the contradictions in the views
	Social	Based on the contradictions of the social sphere
	Domestic	Based on the contradictions of family relations

Classification of conflicts

Base of classification	Kinds of conflicts	General characteristics
The degree of duration of conflict and tension	Rapidly flowing	Based on individual psychological characteristics of personality. Particularly aggressive and extreme hostility.
	Sharp long	Based on deep contradictions
	Mild and indolent	Based on sharp contradictions, or the passivity of one of the parties
	Mild and fleeting	Based on superficial reasons
